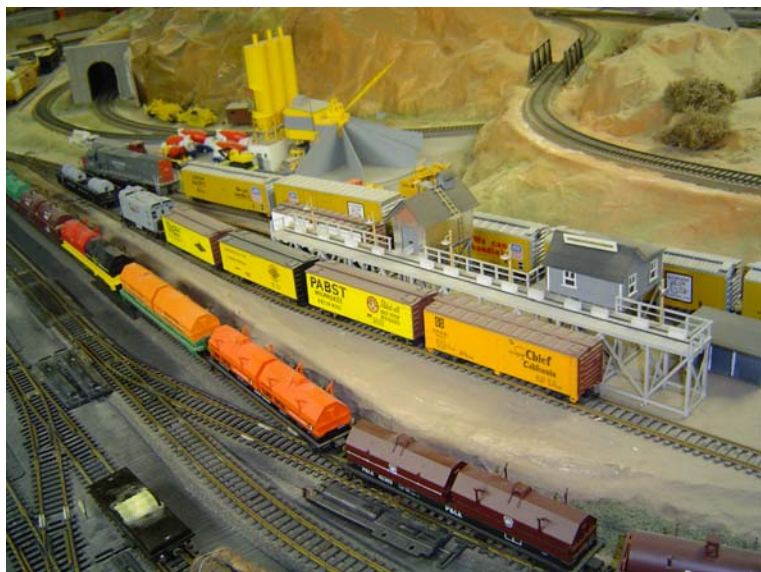

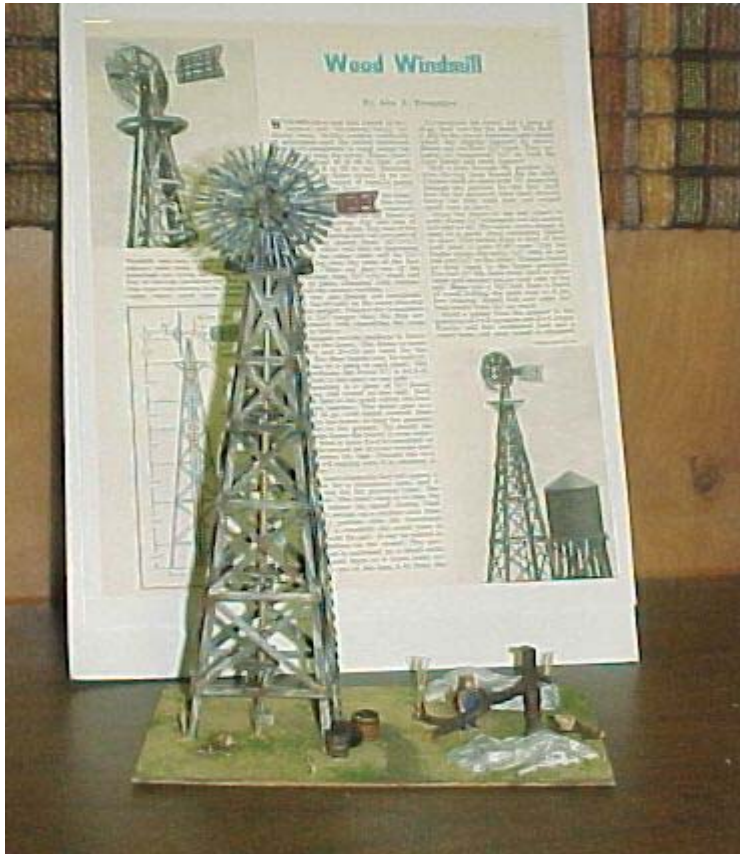


## January Contest Winner
