



types of cars and how a diesel locomotive work. Safety on and round railroads is also stressed. The modeling portion covers scale vs. gauge, building a rolling stock kit. Among the requirements the scout must make a sketch of a proposed model railroad with the necessary design elements to make it work.

Bob Sobotka has taken the lead on this program becoming a certified councilor, and has conducted two merit badge workshops. This was done with model kits donated by Scale Reproductions Hobby Shop and tools provided by the Division. Bob works in conjunction with Joe Fields who has been a councilor for several years. Al Oswald with Operation Life Saver has also provided assistance.

On Saturday January 23, Mike Berry and Ryan Eckler set up our information booth at the "University of Scouting" held at Male High School for area scout leaders. Mike and Brian talked to some of the 700 or so leaders who attended about the Merit Badge Program. 250 brochures were handed out.
